



Ojemba Travel: School Trips.

A journey to Auschwitz is life changing for many people, young and old. We invited to experience one of the most notorious of the Nazi camps, and reflect with your students on the human capacity for cruelty, and be inspired by the stories of heroism that shine through darkness of utter depravity.

Following in the footsteps of the Jewish people, your students will trace their path from the sights and sounds of the Kasimierz, the mediaeval Jewish ghetto in Krakow and film set of Spielberg's epic masterpiece "Schindler's List", and visit the site of the Nazi Ghetto of the 2nd World War and Schindler's Factory. They will learn about life in Krakow during this period and meet someone of unparalleled bravery, a Living Righteous Among the Nations, and be awestruck at their simple courageousness as they tell their story.

Whilst staying in Krakow, you and your students will be able to enjoy time in one of the finest and best preserved mediaeval cities in world, ranked by UNESCO as one of the ten most important and beautiful cities anywhere on earth. Enjoy some of the sumptuous Polish cuisine, and maybe sample the warmth of traditional Polish hospitality. If time allows you will be able to walk through the largest salt mines in the world, or spend time in Krakow's most popular local attraction, the Aqua park, with the longest flume ride in Europe.

Enter the gates of Auschwitz, the largest cemetery in the world, it's brooding presence is iconic for some of the worst atrocities humans have met out on their fellow inhabitants of this planet. See the cell of Maximilian Kolbe, Martyr, and bear witness to our capacity for unbridled cruelty. You will have an extensive study tour of Auschwitz I, the main museum, and take part in workshops exploring different aspects of the Holocaust, making use of the Museum's extensive archives. You will meet a survivor and here their story of life in Auschwitz. Do the 'March of the Living', literally walking in the footsteps of thousands and thousands of prisoners of the camp, as you visit Auschwitz II, Birkenau, the site of the largest killing spree in history. As you breath in the terrible atmosphere, listen to the ground of Auschwitz.

At Ojemba, we want you to be able to share this experience with your students, travelling this path together. With this in mind, and working in collaboration with the Auschwitz Memorial Museum, we offer you a carefully crafted tapestry of guided study tours, workshops in various mediums, reflective times and when possible meetings with a survivor. You will be guided by an educator from the UK who will lead the programme. Situated next to the main camp, the accommodation will be comfortable and secure, and will be full board. There is space to kick a football around and just chill out in safety. We wish to ensure that this once in a lifetime journey is educational, challenging and gives your students every possibility to grow morally and spiritually and to develop their horizons, as well as have fun.
